Hope in the Darkness

God is always giving us new strategies to fruitfully join in as He rescues millions trapped in darkness. We are very thankful for your prayers and walking beside us. You allow us to fully give ourselves to this work. We have a few major updates we'd like to share with you that took place just before we left in mid-June.

We'll keep it simple and start with this one update:

In the Spring of 2022, we participated in an outreach for Ramadan via digital strategies, and it was so touching to celebrate 109 new believers at the end of the month. This year, in 2023, we were able to participate once more through prayer, fasting, and supporting the digital team. This digital team was made up of only FOUR people at our Orlando headquarters who were typing and texting for a month (500+ hours total!) as inquiries from our social media ads came in. Our ads reached 7,337,881 people in the country we had selected. Out of that, this small digital team shared the gospel with 4,982 people, resulting in 222 new believers! That is in one month in countries closed to or hostile to the gospel of Jesus. The ads we placed were directed at those who were seeking answers about faith and Jesus. New believers were taken through online follow-up materials and then introduced to someone in their home country. The multiplication continues! Since then, the new believers have been sharing with their family and friends.

Story of "D"




D accepted Christ in live messaging during the fourth week of Ramadan.
